Course Objective

The objective is to teach the students and teachers music techniques that will improve listening, intonation and offer ways for students to learn English using music.

Learning through songs is a great opportunity to combine students' interests and learning the language. If the students are interested in a song, they will be determined to understand it. Some children find it hard to speak English because they are shy or lack confidence. Singing with other people can help. It creates a safe space for children to practise expressing themselves aloud. You don't have to be musical, just enthusiastic!

Session Structure

The session is structured in such a way to ensure a range of varied activities.

- Introduction
- Vocal Warm-up
- Pronunciation exercises
- Conducting an Orchestra game - beat and rhythm
- Intro to the Beatles, -using songs to learn grammatical structures and understand lyrics
- Singing as a choir

Songs by The Beatles are particularly useful for English learners for a number of reasons. First of all, the lyrics are often sung clearly and slowly, allowing even beginner level learners of English to understand them. The lyrics are often quite simple, with relatively basic structures repeated throughout the songs. In fact, they're so catchy that you really can't help singing along and practicing the words!

Learning Outcomes

Students will learn how to position their mouths to make different sounds, how connected speech sounds and how weak and strong vowels shape and phrase and give rhythm to an expression.
